## A NOTE FROM YOUR CHIEF STEWARD

A reminder of the differences between a Union Steward and a Key Person.

CUPE 4186 **does not** have Stewards in every school. Our **Stewards** are trained to deal with Management and the Employer, are able to file grievances and have the ability to speak to your Supervisor on your behalf. They also attend monthly meetings, sign an Oath of Confidentiality and are up to date on Collective Agreement issues affecting our Local.

Every work location has a **Key Person**. These important members hand out information that comes from our Local Office. Key Persons can also direct you whom to call in case of an issue, but they cannot sit in a meeting with you or represent you in front of your Supervisor.

Even Supervisors need a reminder that according to our **Collective Agreement**, only Stewards can sit in on meetings. Stewards are assigned by the Chief Steward. Please call the Office or my cell if your Supervisor is insistent on you bringing in a coworker. It is important to have proper representation when you meet with the Employer!
